


What's in a Name?



The Granville area is the birthplace of Association Football (soccer) in Australia. The Granville & Districts Soccer Football Association is the oldest association in Australia being founded nearly a century ago (1902).

"Granville" has a rich and proud soccer tradition and as being a member of the Association. Indeed Granville was the engine room and powerhouse of Australian Soccer well into the 1940's with a number of national representatives. There was the Granville Magpies, the oldest club in Australia and Granville Kewpies, the oldest club in continuous existence.

Granville Waratah Soccer Football Club was originally founded in 1904. It operated for a number of years before being disbanded. But fifty four years ago the club was re-founded. Our home ground was Brunton Field, now the site of the Granville RSL Club on the corner of William and Clyde Streets. Some thirty years ago the club relocated to Robin Thomas Reserve, Parramatta. So why are we still called Granville?

Until recently the question of changing our clubs geographical name hasn't really been an issue but lately the question has.

During the off season members of the clubs Executive committee decided to review the clubs name and to put the question to a vote later in the season. The club will be looking for your input. Consider these questions...

Would changing our name;

- a. assist future player recruitment?
- b. make corporate club sponsorship more attractive?, or
- c. detract from our clubs history?

For a number of years many clubs have tried to adopt the name of "Parramatta", but for the National Soccer League's Parramatta Power, none of these clubs are actually based in Parramatta City...we are! So are we missing an opportunity? And if so, for how much longer are we going to let it slip by?


