A very good result for us, putting us top of the pile with Greystanes Black going down. The boys outplayed Merrylands for 55 of the 70m minutes – let's stay there boys.

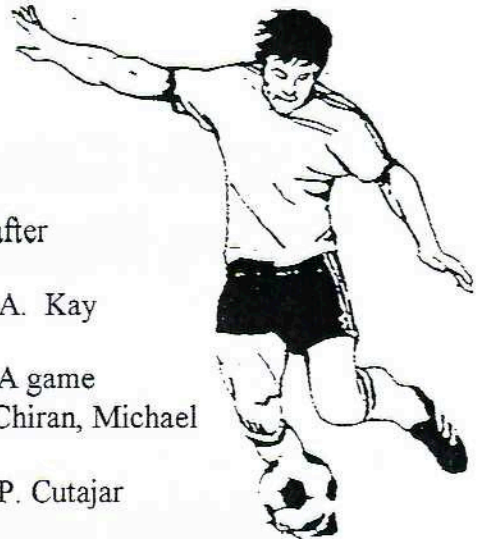

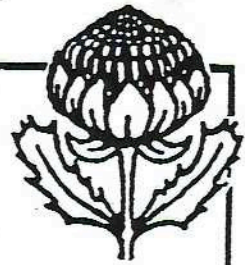
